Available on the web site are details of the **Burton Joyce Heritage Trail**.

Refreshments can be obtained at three pubs in the village – The Cross Keys, The Wheatsheaf, & The Lord Nelson, as well as at two tea shops

The Trail is approx. 1 mile/1½ kms, and is on good walking surfaces with no stiles.

Also try the **Bulcote Heritage Trail**. No pubs to visit, but within walking distance of any of the Burton Joyce hostelries. Length approx 1 mile / 1½ kms. Good walking surfaces, flat and no stiles.

Both Trails have Interpretive Display Panels on the route depicting local features.
